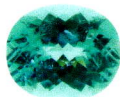
Result: PARAÍBA-TYPE TOURMALINE

Comments: This copper and manganese bearing elbaite tourmaline is referred to commercially as a 'paraíba tourmaline'. The name 'paraíba' is derived from the Brazilian state where this gemstone was first mined. Today, however, the gemstones may also originate from Nigeria and Mozambique
